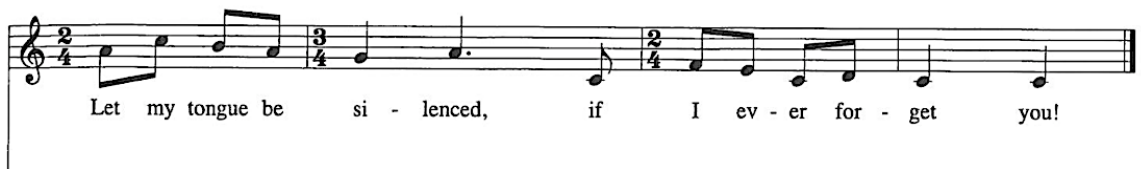

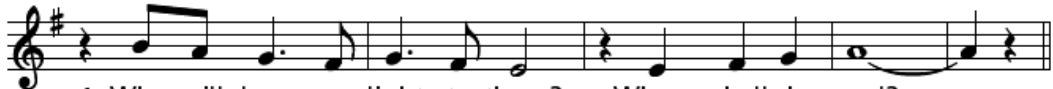

Make us your missionary disciples!

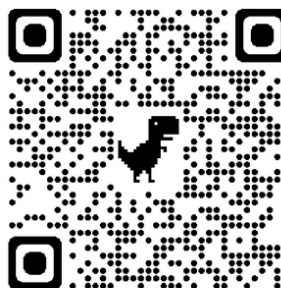
